Fig. 1.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 1.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 1.3 Diagram of indicators regarding the level of needs among respondents in the Kyiv region:








Fig. 1.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kyiv region




Fig. 2.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 2.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Chernihiv region








Fig. 2.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in Chernihiv region





Fig. 3.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 3.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 3.3 Diagram of indicators regarding the level of needs among respondents in Cherkasy region








Fig. 3.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in Cherkasy region










Fig. 4.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 4.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 4.3 Diagram of indicators regarding the level of needs among respondents in the Poltava region









Fig. 4.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Poltava region




Fig. 5.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 5.3 Diagram of indicators regarding the level of needs among respondents in the Kirovohrad region









Fig. 5.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kirovohrad region




Fig. 6.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 6.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kharkiv region








Fig. 6.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kharkiv region

Fig. 7.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 7.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 7.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kherson region








Fig. 7.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Kherson region






Type of education

Fig. 8.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 8.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 8.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Dnipropetrovsk region








Fig. 8.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in Dnipropetrovsk region



Fig. 9.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 9.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 9.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Sumy region









Fig. 9.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in Sumy region




Fig. 10.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 10.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Mykolaiv region








Fig. 10.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Mykolaiv region



Fig. 11.1 Distribution of survey participants by gender:




Fig. 11.2 Distribution chart by status of survey participants:




Fig. 11.3 Diagram of indicators of the level of needs among respondents in the Zaporizhzhia region








Fig. 11.4 Detailed indicators of the level of needs among respondents in Zaporizhzhia region
